

Delays in the delivery process

CarNet customers will be contacted directly by our Customer Service department to get information about specifically affected delivery delays for new cars of the brands Audi, BMW, Ford, Jaguar, Land Rover, Mercedes-Benz, Opel, Porsche, Skoda Volkswagen and Volvo. Production weeks already confirmed will probably be postponed due to the closures of the production facilities. As soon as an update of the individual brands arrives, our Customer Service team will inform accordingly.

Vehicle maintenance and repair shops

Most garages and repair shops are currently in operation.

Tire suppliers

The majority of our partners informed us of they are reopening in compliance with the FOPH requirements. Ticino is still to be considered a special situation at the moment and must be clarified separately in each case.

Leasing/ Financial markets

The leasing banks operate normally and process all leasing requests. However, the uncertainties in the financial markets will remain in the near future. Volatile interest rates are therefore to be expected.



Interruption of Production

Car brand	Status of the interruption of vehicle manufacturing
BMW, Mini	Production interrupted until probably April 30th 2020
Daimler - Mercedes-Benz, Smart	Start of production expected April 20th 2020
FCA - Fiat, Alfa Romeo	No details yet
Ford	Start of production expected May 4th 2020
Porsche	Production still interrupted
PSA - Peugeot, Citroen, DS, Opel	Gradual restart of production as of April 20th 2020
Renault	Production in Europe is still reduced. Part of the operation has been resumed in Portugal and is planned for the facility in Romania from April 21st, 2020. Production in Russia was gradually resumed on April 13th 2020.
VAG - VW, Audi, Seat, Skoda	Gradual restart of production at the Zwickau and Bratislava facilities planned as of April 20th, 2020. As of April 27th 2020 gradual restart of production facilities in Portugal, Spain, Russia and USA planned. As of May 2020 reopening of the plants in South Africa, Argentina, Brazil and Mexico planned.

The information changes daily.

In general, we are currently assuming that production will only start gradually in the coming weeks.
